Schwenksville Borough invites businesses, organizations and residents to participate in the Borough's Revitalization. There are numerous ways to get involved, whether it be by sponsoring Community Day or other special events; applying to create a mural on your property; by installing street furniture along your frontage; or by purchasing a sponsorship for an element from our Streetscape Catalog, including public art or murals, benches with dedication plaques, bike racks and posts or a sidewalk medallion. You could also make a donation and earmark it towards a larger item that the Borough is saving up for such as pavilions, ornamental gates and signs, murals, and more. Have an idea not covered? Schwenksville Borough Revitalization Public Engagement Program

Schwenksville Borough adopted its Main Street Schwenksville Streetscape Plan and Design Guidelines in July of 2017. The plan was developed by a Task Force of residents, business owners, staff and officials. A streetscape is all of the visual and physical elements that one encounters while walking or driving down a street.

Well-designed streetscapes function on many levels: they calm traffic, they safely allow pedestrian travel, they accommodate on-street parking, and they provide moments for people to linger. As a whole, a streetscape should contribute to a town's sense of place. While the Borough actively seeks out grants to implement specific elements of the plan such as new sidewalk and curbing, a mural, a pedestrian plaza and park improvements, we have learned from other small towns that "It takes a place to create a community and it takes a community to create a place." {Berlin, MD}

Getting Started

In the back of this booklet you will find a pledge form and a volunteer form. Using this form you can sign up to sponsor a particular element such as a bench or bike rack; you can apply to design and/or sponsor a sidewalk medallion; you can suggest or volunteer a location for public art and you can sponsor a public art installation. You can also make a smaller donation and earmark it for a specific element.

All elements should contribute to and be consistent to the H.E.A.R.T. of Schwenksville theme which stands for "Historic, Engaging, Authentic, Recreational, Timeless".

Sidewalk Medallion Program

The Main Street Plan calls for approximately sixteen to twenty cast bronze medallions to be set in sidewalks along Main Street and Pedestrian access routes. Each medallion will be different and will pay tribute to local culture, a local cultural activity, a local historical building or trade, native plants or animals or patriotic or civic organization.

The 24" diameter Medallions will be embedded in the sidewalk. Sponsors can express a preference for a specific location and submit a design for approval; however all designs and locations must be approved and finalized by Schwenksville Borough.

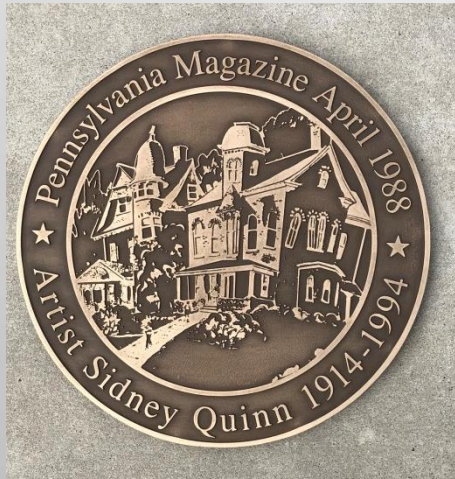
The purpose of this program is to draw attention to culturally and historically significant elements that make Schwenksville unique.

Memorials and Personal dedications will not be permitted and designs that include commercial, religious or political symbols or statements are not eligible.

Creativity is encouraged; possible design elements include historical photographs, natural features and wildlife, cultural activities (biking, kayaking, horseback riding, the railroad, historical industries (ice harvesting, mills, dairies) and civic organizations or patriotic themes.

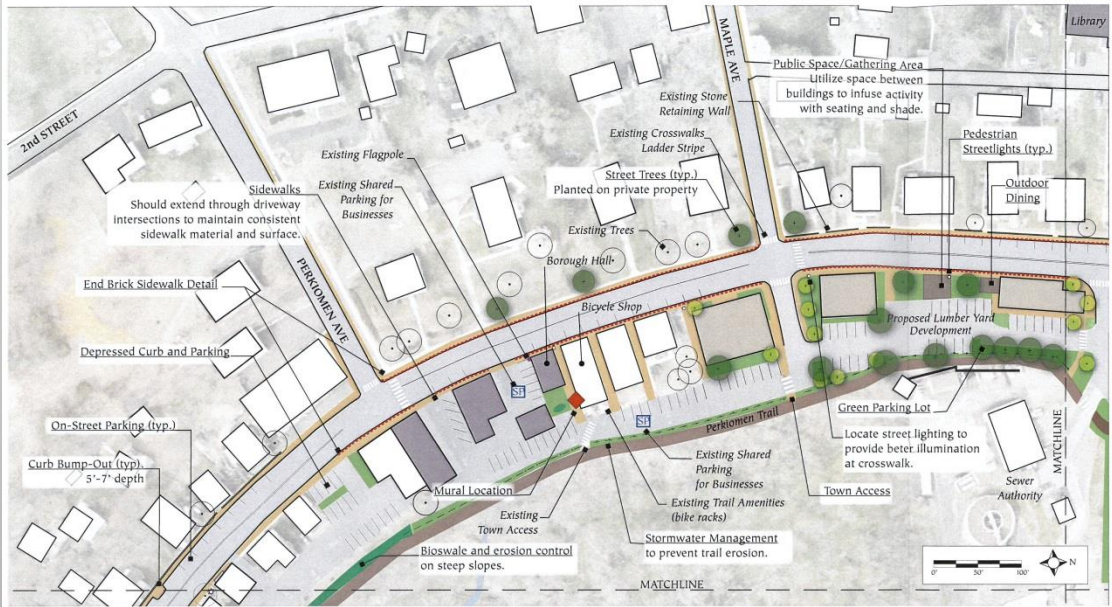

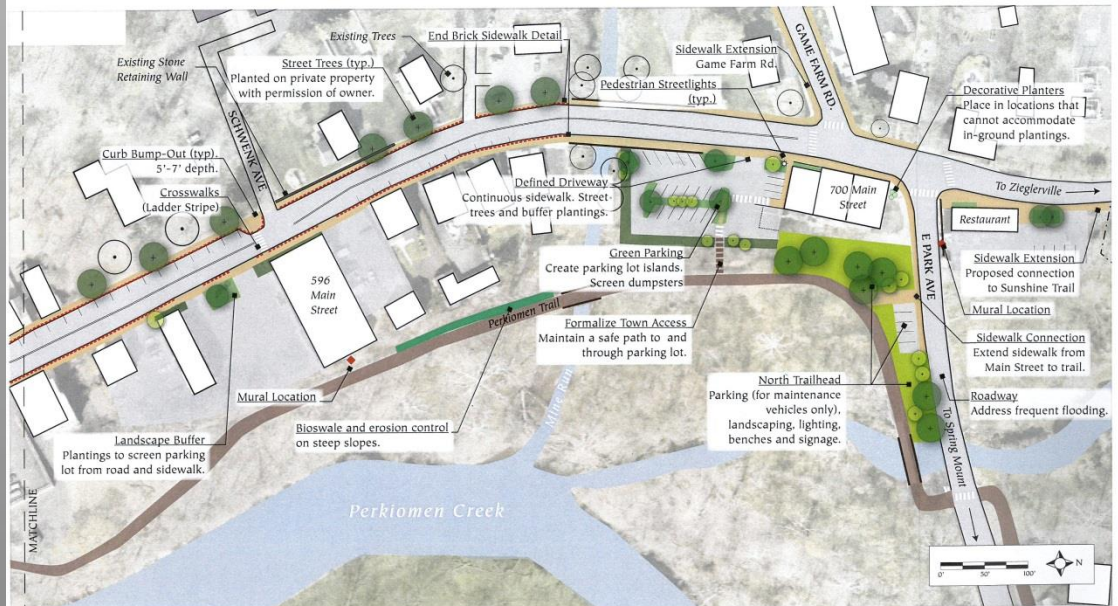
